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The Immaculate Conception Church of St. Martin of Tours Parish will award a scholarship to a student who has shown academic excellence, character, integrity, and leadership, and who exemplifies what it is “To Know, To Love, and To Serve God and Neighbor.”

The scholarship is intended to help the recipient defray the cost of higher education. It is available to an active member of the St. Martin of Tours at Immaculate Conception Church. The applicant must be: (1) a graduate from high school in June of the current year and planning to attend an accredited diploma/degree granting institution of higher learning the following year or (2) a student currently attending or planning to attend an accredited diploma/degree granting institution of higher learning.

The criteria used to evaluate the scholarship application will include:

1. Sacraments received.
2. Service to the Church, school, and community.
3. Extracurricular activities.
4. Work experience.

In addition to the application form the candidate must provide the following:

1. Two letters of recommendation from other than family members.
